**Fondwa**, a mountainous village in rural Haiti is about two hours from Port-au-Prince and 30 minutes from Jacmel. The Association of Peasants of Fondwa (APF) has been working in rural sustainable development in this community since 1988.

Before 1988, *this was the experience*: Lack of potable water, no health care facility, no school, no technical assistance to the farmers, no road, high deforestation, no financial services and no access to communication, high rate of adult illiteracy and no social services. *APf has changed this experience with*: more than 15 water sources captured serving over 700 families, a Clinic, a Kindergarten, Elementary, High School and University, specialists working with farmers, a rough road half-paved, model forests and over 500,000 trees planted, a Credit Union, a radio station, an internet service, an orphanage and an order of religious women, the Sisters of St. Anthony of Fondwa.

**What is the Visitor's Program?** A six-day and five night program: The first and last nights are spent in Port-au-Prince at our Solidarity Guest House. Generally, there is flexibility in the scheduling of activities:

**Day 1:** Port-au-Prince: Visit the city and have orientation on the current political and economic situation.



**Day 2:** Arrive in Fondwa with your guide. Welcome to the Community Center; receive the schedule of events.



Assist in orientation and two presentations from APF members in the Center; cultural entertainment in the evening.

**Days 3 to 5:** Variable Programs: Each day will focus on a different topic and will include work activities, visits with local people; and seminars on the theme of the day.
